Agrees that the GST is an opportunity to work towards a shared vision of/ operationalizing the concept of equity.

Page 4-4.

Agrees to request to the COP to establish at this twenty-four session a “Task Force on an Equity Common Reference” that elaborates a common reference, to be approved by CMA in its plenary meeting in 2019, that operationalize equity in a simple referential quantified manner with the aim to assess the level of fairness and/or ambition of the nationally determined contributions. This individualized equity common reference shall be coherent with the achievement of the global temperature goal as described in Article 2.1(a) of the Paris Agreement.
